Tammy Schultz

Tammy Schultz, Ph.D., LMHC, LAC is a professor in the Grace College Graduate Department of Counseling and Interpersonal Relations. Tammy has taught at Grace for 18 years and has a small private practice. She was awarded the 2010 Indiana Counselor of the Year by the Indiana Counseling Association. He founded Stuck Christians, an organization designed to help believers deal with pains and hurts often neglected in the faith community. Thomas is currently working on an MA in Psychology and Counseling.

Victoria Kepler Didato, MA, LSW, LPC, DAPA is the founder and director of the Child Sexual Abuse Institute of Ohio located in Wooster, Ohio. She received her undergraduate degree in criminal justice from Pennsylvania State University and her masters in child and family development from the University of Akron. She received her certification in formational counseling from Ashland Theological Seminary. She is both a licensed social worker and a counselor in the State of Ohio and holds Diplomate status in the American Psychotherapy Association.

Vincent Didato, PCC-S has been in private practice since 1990, specializing in marital & family therapy, trauma recovery, spiritual formation & healing, and overcoming sexual abuse. An ordained minister, Vince served on a pastoral team for six years prior to his working as a therapist.
